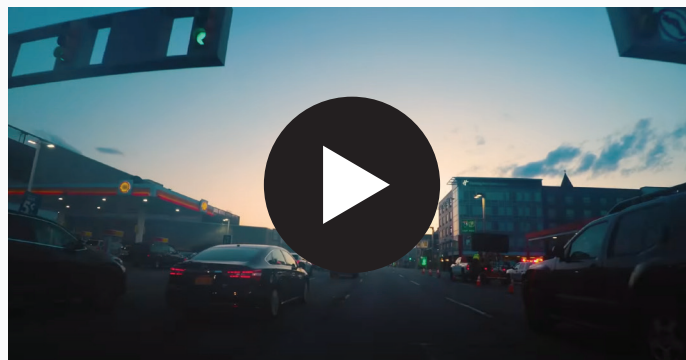
**Mission Statement:** Support those who operate, improve, and maintain public works and infrastructure through advocacy, education, and member engagement.
